Dr. Robert F. Dyer PhD “Bob”, beloved husband, father, grandfather, educator, and community servant, passed away on April 28, 2026, at the age of 82.

Born on July 15, 1943, in Youngstown, Ohio, to Fred C. and Linnea B. Dyer, Bob built a life defined by love of family, intellectual curiosity, dedication and generosity.

Bob earned his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and MBA from Bowling Green State University. He earned his PhD in Business Administration from the University of Maryland. He devoted the next forty years to the George Washington University School of Business, where he taught marketing and served as Associate Dean of the Executive MBA Program. He shaped the minds of countless students and left an indelible mark on the field of business education.

Beyond the classroom, Bob was deeply committed to giving back. He volunteered with INROADS of Greater Washington and most recently Habitat for Humanity. Bob maintained 38 years of sobriety through AA and was deeply committed to helping others on their own journey to recovery. A passionate golfer, he was a longtime member of Fauquier Springs Country Club.

Bob is survived by his wife Ann-Marie Brisbois-Dyer, whom he shared 34

He was preceded in death by his parents, Fred C. and Linnea B. Dyer; brother, David Dyer; and his son, Ben Dyer.
