Robert E. Hall (91) died on July 27, 2012 at his home in Alexandria, VA. A long time resident of Alexandria and a native of Minneapolis, MN. He was a graduate of Minneapolis Business College and majored in Chemical Engineering at the University of Minnesota. He served with the 508th Parachute Regiment of the 82nd Airborne Division in Germany during World War II. His 34 year career with the U.S. Army included 30 years with the Corps of Engineers, including overseas assignments in the West Indies, Puerto Rico, Okinawa, Japan, Taiwan, Iran, Italy and Germany. He also served 3 years as head Management Analyst in the Corps' division office in Cincinnati, retiring in 1980 as Chief Management Officer after 14 years in the Corps' headquarters in Washington, DC. He was a long-time member and officer in various chapters of the Society of American Military Engineers and the American Society of Military Comptrollers. He also served for several years as guest speaker at Syracuse Graduate School and an adviser to the Department of Agriculture Graduate School on Management curricula. Survivors include his wife, Irene Luise Hall of Alexandria, VA, his son Marc E Hall, daughter in law Kim Hall and grandchildren Chad Logan and Kate Hall, all of Nokesville, VA.
