Robert John McNickle, age 69 of Haymarket, Virginia died on Thursday, June 15, 2006 at Inova Fairfax Hospital.

Mr. McNickle was a graduate of Linsley Military Institute and a Magna Cum Laude Graduate of the University of West Florida. He was a retired MGYSGT of the United States Marine Corp and served in Viet Nam. He was also a retired Systems Analyst for Boeing Computer Service and SAIC.
