



## Ronald Harrison Long

June 7, 1943 - June 3, 2023

Ron was born in Clearfield, Pennsylvania on June 7, 1943 to Jacob Alexander Long and Margaret Elizabeth Rumery. He went to school in Clearfield and graduated in 1961 from Clearfield Area Senior High School. In 1965, he met Mary Jane (Bonnie) Bowers and, after their first date, Bonnie told her mother that “she had just met the man she will marry.” They wed on a sunny June day and would have been celebrating their 58th anniversary this month.

Ron worked as a distributor for Charles Chips, spending many hours driving a white striped van loaded with chips, pretzels, and cookies. He remained a faithful, hard-working employee with the company when it later became Virginia Heritage Food. He also had been a dedicated member of the Park West Lions, the “Red Derby Club,” for many years, currently holding the rank of 1st Vice President.

Ron is survived by his wife, Bonnie Long, his siblings Peggy Tobiasson, Bob Long, and Bill Long, and his grandchildren, Anna-Leigh, Garreth, Gracelyn, and Harrison Moore. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Monica Sue Long.
