Roy Alan Madill, age 66, of Mathias, West Virginia, formerly of Woodbridge Virginia, died Monday, April 28, 2014 at UVA Medical Center, Charlottesville. Mr. Madill was born November 30, 1947 in Manassas, Virginia, son of the late Paul Gray Madill, Sr. and Janie Mauck Madill. He was also predeceased by a brother, Paul Gray Madill, Jr.

He was a member of VFW Lost River Valley Post 7780 in Mathias, WV, having served in the United States Army for 2 years, including a tour of duty in Vietnam and honorably discharged in 1970. . He was retired from a career with the United States Postal Service. Roy loved spending time with his family, hunting, NASCAR and the Washington Redskins.
