April 8, 1924 - October 24, 2006

RUBY KATHLEEN CLEMEN, age 82 of Nokesville, Virginia died Tuesday, October 24, 2006 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas.

She was a lifetime active member of Asbury United Methodist Church in the community of Aden, Virginia and one of the original founding members of the Prince William Veterans's Farm Club Ladies Auxiliary, sponsoring and assisting the Veteran's of the Prince William County Fair for 57 years. She supported the war effort welding in the shipyards of Baltimore, Maryland during World War II. After the war, she partnered with her husband, Kemp, in dairy business at Tumbledown Farm in Nokesville, Virginia. Giving of her time and talents as a 4-H leader, she taught community youth life-skills of leadership, sewing, and gardening in her rural community. Her passion and perfection of the art of quilting complimented her natural talent as a seamstress. She was an avid cook, gardener, and had a special love for the beauty of flowers and birds.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Charles P. and Bessie Kinser Jones, one brother and one sister.

Survivors include her loving husband of 61 years, Kemp B. Clemen; four children, Catherine Clemen of Warrenton, VA, Linda Simms and Burnard Clemen both of Nokesville, VA and Lillian Jacobs of The Plains, VA; four

brothers; seven sisters; nine grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.
