



Rufus Bostic Jr.

April 3, 1931 - July 27, 2020

Rufus Bostic, Jr., of Manassas, Virginia was called home to be with the Lord on Monday, July 27, 2020. Born on April 3, 1931 in Fayetteville, North Carolina, he was the beloved husband of Mildred Bostic, his wife of 65 years. His passing has left a tremendous void in our lives, but he will forever be in our hearts.

Rufus was a 27-year career Army veteran and loved being in the military. Having served his country during the Korean War Conflict in the early 50's, he also had back-to-back assignments in Japan. He served in both Thailand and Alaska on isolated assignments. His last tour of duty brought him to Virginia where he retired in 1977 and decided to make Virginia a permanent home. After retiring from the military, he was employed by the Central Intelligence Agency at Fort Belvoir for over 20 years.

The role he treasured most was serving on the ministerial staff at Chantilly Baptist Church. He was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel on July 28, 1996. Being in the pulpit, gave him great joy. He loved serving with his pastor, Rev. Dr. Jerry Bryant who was also a dear friend. He loved preaching Jesus.

He is survived by his loving wife Mildred and two children, a daughter, Gail Bostic Mobley, and a son, Rufus Bostic III. He loved his grandchildren Ryan, Emilee and Brandon and his great-daughter Avery. He was known to them as "Papa". They gave him great joy.

Family will receive friends on Monday, August 3, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. until time of service at 11:00 a.m. at Pierce Funeral Home, 9606 Center Street, Manassas, VA. Interment will follow at Chantilly Baptist Church cemetery in Chantilly, VA.

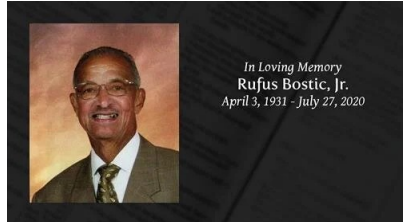
