RUSSELL PAUL MADILL, of Brunswick, Maine and Manassas, Virginia passed away Monday, November 1, 2004 in Brunswick.

Petty Officer Madill was serving with the US Navy stationed with Patrol Squadron 10, NAS in Brunswick.

Petty Officer Madill was born May 9, 1981 in Utica, New York, the son of Paul Madill and Suzanne Madill. Russell grew up in the Manassas area and attended schools there. He received his high school diploma from the State of Maine. He was employed by Clarks Automotive in Manassas before entering the Navy in February 2001. Madill had advanced his rank in a short time.
