Ruth E Batcheller passed away quietly at her residence at the Village at Arbor Terrace of Sudley Manor in Manassas, VA on May 21, 2016. She was born in Waterloo, NY to parents, Charles E and Marion (Cornish) Rowley, on November 16, 1920. Ruth was the fifth of eight siblings, of which she was the last survivor.

She was preceded in death by her daughter Jean Carol Batcheller in 2002 and by her husband Coleman Carter Batcheller Jr. in 2004 whom she married in August 1940. They resided most of their married life in McLean, VA until health issues made it necessary for her to move into assisted living.

Upon graduation from high school, she and one of her girlfriends hitchhiked south from Canandaigua, NY to seek employment. Upon reaching the outskirts of Alexandria, VA she was offered a ride by her future husband. She worked several jobs in retail before finally being hired by General Motors Corporation. She worked for Pontiac Motor Division in the regional office thirty one years, having never missed a day on the job.

Interment is planned in the near future for her cremated remains along with those of her daughter and husband in Ivy Hill Cemetery, Alexandria, VA.
