Ryan Patrick Fox was born on April 10, 1984 in Morgantown, WV and unexpectedly passed away peacefully at his home in Bristow, VA on Monday, July 29, 2024 at the young age of 40. To his friends he was only known as FOX. He graduated from Osbourn City High School, Manassas VA in 2002 where he played baseball, tennis and hockey. His hockey skills were initially developed on the ponds of Clarkston, MI but were a bit unrefined for organized hockey. 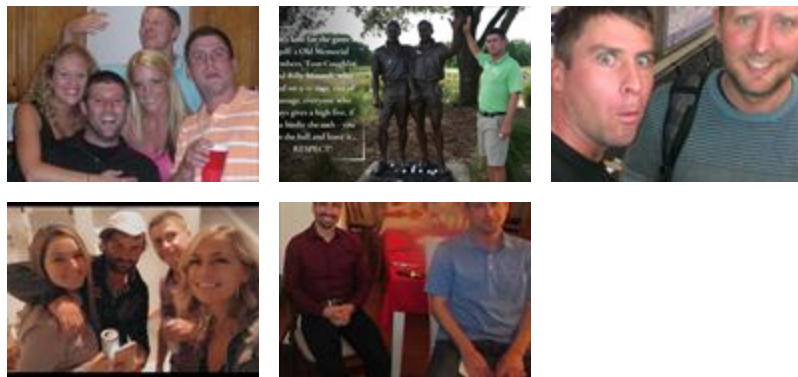
