SEAN RUSSELL CUTSFORTH, 22, of Christiansburg and Manassas, Va. died in the line of duty on December 15, 2010 in Ghazni, Afghanistan.

Sean was born at Fort Belvoir on August 29, 1988, to Robert and Vickie Cutsforth of Manassas, Va. He was a Specialist in the United States Army 101st Airborne and serving in Operation Enduring Freedom. Sean attended Brentsville High School and was well recognized for his athletic abilities, particularly, his love of baseball, swimming and the outdoors. He was very active in the Greater Manassas Baseball League, Ben Lomond Swim Team and Greater Manassas Football League. He was an exemplary teammate and mentor. Sean made everyone feel welcome and accepted for who they were. He was wise beyond his years and never took a day for granted. Sean cared deeply for his family and friends. He will be greatly missed and never forgotten by the many lives he touched.
