“ I have many wonderful memories growing with the Singer kids in Falls Church. We had so many adventures in that neighborhood. We frequently reacted fire and rescue operations which I recall usually involved little Joe next door as the victim. We put on several plays in their basement and invited the neighbors to attend, Since we all attended the Catholic school together, we often set up the confessional in our upstairs bathroom. Usually either my brother Jeff or Arthur played the priest by sitting in the tub with the shower curtain drawn. Each of us would take turns going to confession. The idea was you would knock once on the tub for a venial sin and knock twice for a mortal sin. We once spent several weeks trying to dig a swimming pool in their back yard. What resulted was a muddy hole unfit for use. I recall several Christmases we went around the neighborhood signing carols and hoping the neighbors would give us some change or cookies which they often did. Given our normal's today growing up on Oakwood Dr in the 1950's seem so quaint but what I would give to go back and live that way again.
