December 12, 1938 - June 8, 2016

Stanley R. Hagenhoff, age 77, of Manassas, Virginia went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, June 8, 2016 at his home surrounded by his family.

Stan was born on December 12, 1938 in Cincinnati, OH to the late George Herman and Wilhemina (Manns) Hagenhoff. Stan attended the University of Cincinnati on ROTC scholarship and graduated with honors earning a degree in Electrical Engineering. Following graduation, he received his commission as a 2nd Lieutenant into the United States Army and served tours in Korea and Vietnam. He later received post-graduate degrees in Operations Research from The United States Naval Post Graduate School and Strategy Management in Naval Operations from the Naval War College. Stan served his country in the Army for 20 years in Kwajalein, California, New Mexico, Rhode Island, and Virginia, attaining the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. After retiring in 1981, he worked as a government contractor with the Department of Defense. He was a member of the Manassas Baptist Church where he was involved in many areas of service. Stan loved music and sang in both the church choir and the Manassas Community Chorale. Stan loved his God, his family, and his country. Stan's quiet strength, humility, wisdom, guidance and laughter will be missed by all who knew him.

Survivors include his loving wife of 55 years, Sally E. Hagenhoff of Manassas, VA; three children: Jennifer Cooper and husband Taylor, Susan Starnes and

husband Mark, and Steven Hagenhoff and wife Cindy all of Manassas, VA; eight grandchildren: Whitney, Mattie, Zach, Alex, Justin, Sara, Jeremiah and Benjamin as well as numerous nieces, nephews and extended family. Stan was preceded in death by his sister Wilma Hagenhoff Alexander and his brother Robert Hagenhoff.
