August 21, 1943 - January 19, 2023

Stanley Maurice Keys, age 79, passed away on Thursday, January 19, 2023, at the Capital Caring Hospice Adler Center in Aldie, VA.

He was born on August 21, 1943, to the late Hazel Diehl and Maurice Keys. He was raised in Brentsville, VA and was a 1963 graduate of the Brentsville District High School in Nokesville, VA. Following graduation, he worked various jobs at local banks, ultimately becoming the bank manager of Carter Bank & Trust in Nokesville.

Stanley married Elizabeth Nadine Persinger, and the two shared in a variety of mutual interests throughout their marriage. They enjoyed several years of square dancing with the Farmers and Charmers, participating in the Nokesville Day Parade, and dancing in the Southern States (now Hector's) parking lot. Stan was happiest when he was helping others and was an active member of several civic organizations including the Manassas Jaycees, the Nokesville Business Association, the Ruritans, and Friends Uniting Nokesville. Additionally, he was instrumental in starting the Nokesville Christmas Parade and tree lighting. He was fondly known as the "Mayor of Nokesville!"

Stan was a life-long member of the Nokesville Church of the Brethren, where he served as a trustee.

In addition to his beloved wife Nadine, Stan was preceded in death by his parents, his sister Peggy Keys Venere, and his sister in law, Betty Lou Persinger.

Family and friends will gather for a Celebration of Life for Stanley Keys, on Saturday, February 4, 2023, at 12:00 PM at the Nokesville Church of the Brethren, 13002 Fitzwater Dr., Nokesville, VA 20181. A reception will follow.
