Stephen Michael Maltman, 76, of Gainesville, VA, died peacefully at home of vascular dementia on January 15, 2025.

Steve was born in Chicago in 1948 to Edward Spencer and Jane Murphy Maltman. In 1951 the family moved to California where he grew up. Steve enlisted in the Navy in January of 1968 before moving to Virginia with his beautiful wife, Karen Lynn Martin, in 1972. He then began a long career in IT, culminating in 33 years at George Mason University as a systems analyst. He was happiest in nature surrounded by wildlife or at home surrounded by Stephen King novels.

Stephen was preceded in death by his father Edward Spencer Maltman, his mother Jane Murphy Maltman, his son Stephen Michael Maltman II, his granddaughter Sydney Emaline Zimmerman, and his beloved in-laws. He is survived by his dedicated wife of 53 years, Karen Lynn Martin Maltman, his brothers Richard Maltman, John Welcome, and Craig Maltman, his son Matthew Edward Maltman (and wife Valerie Anne), his daughter Kristin Lynn Maltman Zimmerman (and husband Carson Freas), and his grandson Edward Michael Zimmerman, and many other family members and friends he held so dear.
