



## Surinder Nath Setia

October 27, 1935 - July 27, 2021

On Tuesday, July 27, 2021, Surinder Nath Setia, loving husband, father, and grandfather, passed away at 85.

He had a love for life that was matched only by his love of family and great food. He was born on October 27, 1935, in Lahore, India, the middle son of Krishna Mehta and Bisheshar Nath Setia. He grew up with his older brother, Devinder, and younger sister, Kusum in Rawalpindi and Delhi. He met his wife, Mohini, while working for the US Embassy in New Delhi in 1960, and they were married in 1963. His first son, Sunil, was born in the summer of 1965, and his second son, Sanjay, in the fall of 1969. The family moved to the United States in 1973. He worked for General Electric for two years. After leaving GE, he joined the World Bank, where he remained until his retirement in 1990.

He led a full, happy life with varied interests, including reading, films, and extensive travel. He will be greatly missed by his wife, sons, daughters-in-law Sharda and Nidhi, and his four grandchildren, Karishma, Shaan, Megha, Arjun, and his extended family in the US and abroad.

He was a kind-hearted, larger-than-life personality who will be missed today and forever.
