Teresa "Terry" Ward Landon, 64, of Manassas, VA, passed away January 30, 2013, at Prince William County Hospital in Manassas. She was born April 29, 1948, in Salisbury, MD, to Mack T. Ward and E. Pauline Ward and grew up in Stockton, MD. In addition to her parents, Terry was preceded in death by three brothers, Richard Ward, Bruce Ward and Bobby Ward.
