Throughout his life, Terry was deeply committed to his work and his community. He spent 36 years at Lockheed Martin, including 20 years at the legendary Skunk Works division, where he contributed to groundbreaking projects such as the U-2, F-117, and SR-71. He also spent eight years at Lockheed Martin's corporate office, helping to shape the company's future. His work played a vital role in advancing aviation and defense technology.

Beyond his professional achievements, Terry dedicated himself to serving others. He was a volunteer firefighter and later devoted his retirement years to the Boys & Girls Club of Bluffton, where he served as president for three years. During the economic recession of 2007–2010, he worked tirelessly to keep the club's doors open for 600 children, earning the Hope and Opportunity Award for his unwavering leadership. He built a strong donor base that continues to support the organization today, ensuring a lasting impact on

the community. After leaving his role as president, he continued his service as a board member of the Lowcountry Boys & Girls Club.

Terry's faith was a guiding force in his life. He was an active member of St. Luke's Church, where he found great joy in fellowship and service. He was honored with the Good and Faithful Servant plaque, recognizing his steadfast commitment to living out his beliefs through action.

Above all, Terry was a beloved son, brother, husband, father, and grandfather. He cherished time spent with his grandchildren at Colleton River, creating memories filled with laughter and love. His kindness, strength, and unwavering dedication to his family and community will be deeply missed but not forgotten.
