THEODORE G. "TED" POINDEXTER, age 59 of Manassas, Virginia passed away Thursday, June 2, 2005 at Prince William Hospital.

Ted was born June 6, 1945 in Roanoke, Virginia son of the late Mary Frances and Ira C. Poindexter. He served in the United States Air Force (1963-67) and was a veteran of the Vietnam War. He worked for Woodward and Lothrop, Inc. prior to his employment with the Prince William County School Division. He worked and coached at Stonewall Jackson, Osbourn Park and Brentsville District High Schools. An avid sports fan, he was known for his love of the Dallas Cowboys. He was instrumental in the organization of the Bull Run Officials Association where he served as President and officiated softball, basketball and football.
