Thomas John Finn, age 45, of Manassas, VA passed away on Sunday October 7, 2012 in a hunting accident in Rappahannock County Virginia. Tom was born and raised in Toledo, Ohio and was a graduate of Whitmer High School.

Tom served in the U.S. Marines for a number of years, including Operation Desert Storm, during which he earned the Navy Commendation Medal. Once out of the Marines, Tom worked as a driver for the United Parcel Service for over 20 years. He was a lifetime member of the NRA and an avid hunter, spending much of his free time in the outdoors. Tom's love of hunting took him all over the world.

Tom had a warm personality and a kind heart. He was hard working and reliable, always making sure to take care of those he loved in any way he could. His selflessness, integrity, and strong character were evident to anyone who had the fortune of knowing Tom.
