December 9, 1956 - May 14, 2024

Thomas Andrew Goode of Round Hill, Virginia, passed away suddenly on May 14, 2024 at the age of 67 from complications following cancer surgery.

Tom was born December 9, 1956 to Roland and Dorothy Goode in Springfield, Virginia. He was the fourth of seven children and spent most of his childhood in Oakton, Virginia. After Tom graduated from Herndon High School he attended Brigham Young University. He served a full-time mission for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Padova, Italy. After returning to BYU he married Melinda Ann Thomas on July 7, 1979 in the Washington, D.C. temple. He graduated with a degree in Political Science in 1981.

He served in the United States Air Force as a C-130 pilot stationed in various locations including Tokyo, Japan, Tacoma, WA, Little Rock, AR, and Yorktown, VA. He then flew for American Airlines from 1999-2020.

Tom was a devoted member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and served in many callings. Tom and Melinda served an 18-month mission for the church in Rome, Italy after retiring from the Airlines.

His greatest joy came as he and Melinda raised their seven children, Roland, Tim, Steve, Janine, Kelly, Tony, and Anna.

Tom is survived by his wife, Melinda, their seven children, 23 grandchildren, two sisters and one brother (Marti, Clare, and Gordon). He was preceded in death by his parents, a sister (Elizabeth) and a brother (Tim).

Tom is remembered for his optimism, sense of humor, and love of others.
