August 11, 1948 - January 14, 2017

Thomas Michael Hayes, age 68, of Manassas, VA passed away Saturday, January 14, 2017 surrounded by his family.

Thomas was born on August 11, 1948 in New York, NY the son of the late Thomas J. and Helen (Adamo) Hayes. After earning a Purple Heart in Vietnam and retiring as a Special Agent with the FBI, Tom reserved himself to sitting in his favorite chair, watching Fox News and eating soup. He passed knowing another Clinton would not be in the White House. The local coffee suppliers will never financially recover from his loss.

Survivors include his loving wife, Barbara A. Hayes, five children: Suzanne G. Brown and husband Donald of Spotsylvania, VA; Mary H.
