



Thomas Meeks

April 26, 1930 - December 30, 2012

Thomas Leland Meeks, age 82, of Gainesville, VA died Sunday, December 30, 2012 at Prince William Hospital in Manassas, VA. A native of Louisville, KY, he was born April 26, 1930 to the late Roy Leland and Georgia Lloyd (Hampton) Meeks. After distinguishing himself as a student-athlete at the DuPont Manual Training School (1948) in Louisville, KY, "Tommy" received an appointment to the United States Naval Academy where he was graduated with Distinction as a member of the class of 1952. His 30 year career in the United States Navy included tours as a naval aviator, commanding officer of the T.E. Chandler (DD717), and as a member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. Retiring in 1982 at the rank of Captain, Tom was decorated with the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, among many other awards and citations.

Tom was a leader in local church, community and political activities. He served many years on the Board of China Outreach Ministries and was a dedicated follower of Jesus Christ. He was well-known for his quick wit, hearty laugh and deep love of children and family. He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Jacqueline Marshall Meeks, of Crisfield, MD; three sons, Lee, Tom and Don; 9 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren; and one brother, George Mann, of Columbus, OH.

The family will receive friends at Pierce Funeral Home, 9609 Center Street,

Manassas, VA on Friday, January 4, 2013, from 6:00-8:00pm. Funeral services and burial will be held at Greenwich Presbyterian Church, 15305 Vint Hill Rd., Nokesville, VA at 2:30pm on Saturday, January 5, 2013.
