Thomas Andrew Narron died September 18, 2017 in Manassas, VA.

Thomas was born the beloved third son of Kathleen and James Narron August 16, 1990 in Fairfax County, VA. He graduated Osbourn High School where he was the Captain of his Lacrosse team and his favorite subjects were Engineering and Electronics. Thomas attended Northern Virginia Community College. He proudly served his country as PFC in the United States Marine Corps.

Thomas was employed at Global Com as a Cable Technician but was most happy in his natural element: outside. He maintained an abundant and flourishing garden for many of his family members and often tended to his grandparents' yards. Known as Mountain Man, Thomas loved camping, kayaking, fishing, and riding the beach waves.

Thomas was known for his love and compassion for others. Always a shoulder to cry on, Thomas was available to help anyone in a time of need. Thomas' legendary blue eyes were matched only by the depth of his soft heart.

He is survived by his parents; brothers Robert, David, Michael, and Jayden; niece Aurora and grandparents Jim and Ruth Narron and Chuck and Mary Bennett as well as numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.
