March 16, 1923 - April 5, 2010

GENEVA THORPE JORDAN of Manassas, passed away at Prince William Hospital on April 5, 2010.

Having just celebrated her 87th birthday, she was born to John and Alice Shafer Thorpe in Fauquier County on March 16, 1923. She was predeceased by her two husbands, Andrew Worth Sampsell, "Tom", in 1960 and Charles Richard Jordan "Dick", in 2001; a son, William Wade Jordan, and two siblings, Snowden Jackson Thorpe and Bessie Lunceford.

Mrs. Jordon attended and graduated from Marshall High School in Fauquier County and attended Strayer's College for a brief period before starting to work for the Federal Government in Washington, D.C. She married Tom Sampsell in 1947 when they subsequently moved back to Fauquier County and where she worked at Vint Hill Farms Station until her retirement in 1976.
