November 25, 1939 - July 15, 2020

Timothy Patrick Keenan died on July 15, 2020 with congestive heart failure. He was born in Philadelphia, PA on November 25, 1939 to Joseph Edward and Winifred McKeever Keenan. He graduated from Father Judge High School in Philadelphia and Drexel University with a BS in Mechanical Engineering. He also studied at University of California-Berkeley and University of Pennsylvania. Tim worked as a systems engineer for the US Navy and Pacer Systems before moving to Manassas, VA to work for IBM. After he retired from IBM, Tim taught math at Osbourn Park High School for 11 years.

Tim enjoyed reading, history, solving math problems, genealogy, watching British television, theatre, traveling and his beloved family. He is survived by daughters, Jody Keenan and Maura Gondek (SGM Derek), his son Tim (Kristen), his brother Joseph of Pleasanton, CA, brother-in-law Gerard J. McGlone of West Chester, PA and grandchildren Tim and Patrick Keenan, Ellie, Winnie and Zoey Gondek, and Kyle Hugues. He is preceded in death by his wife of 56 years, Josephine Anne (Joanne), who died in February, 2020.
