Victor Ellsworth Mosher, 75, of Manassas, Virginia left us peacefully on October 16, 2024, surrounded by friends and family. A beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother and uncle. 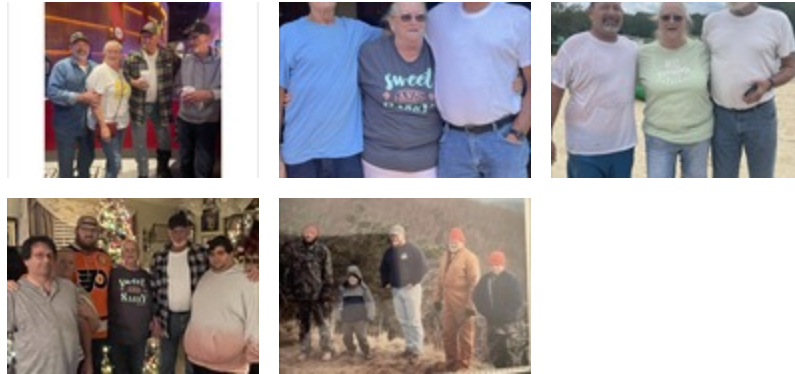
