Vincent T. Falchetta, 91, of Bristow, Virginia, passed away on February 26, 2025. Vincent was born to Joseph and Cosimina Falchetta on October 4, 1933, in Bayonne, New Jersey. He enjoyed fond memories of growing up with his family and working with his father and brothers on job sites. He had plans to be a mechanical technician.
