WALTER JOHN WILEY, 52, a certified Mapping Scientist, died of Multiple Myeloma cancer on August 2, 2008 at home surrounded by loved ones in Gainesville, Virginia.

Mr. Wiley was born in Troy, NY and was a graduate of State University of New York at Plattsburgh.

Throughout his career, Walt was employed by the State of New York, Lizard Tech in Seattle, Wicomico County in Maryland, and most recently as Director of Commercial Sales for Geo Eye in Dulles, Virginia. He also was Founder and President of Mapping Science, Inc. whose customers included the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and Lockheed-Martin Space Systems.

His interests included mountain climbing, skiing, canoeing, golfing, running, and bird watching.
