Warren A. Hedrick, 80 of Clifton, VA passed away on November 12, 2021. A native of California he joined the Air Force following high school and he graduated from the institute of Far Eastern Languages at Yale University. He also received a bachelor's degree in computer science from the University of Nebraska. After completion of his military service, the Hedrick family settled in Fairfax County where Mr. Hedrick worked as a private consultant to government agencies and private businesses.
