Stewart Warren Polen, of Manassas, Virginia died on Friday, January 19, 2018 at his home. He was born January 5, 1930 in Prince William County, Virginia and lived his entire life in Prince William County and Manassas, Virginia.

Warren was a graduate of Osbourn High School and a veteran of the Korean War. Afterwards he worked for HESCO in Manassas and subsequently was the co-owner of Showcase Furniture also in Manassas. Warren retired and closed Showcase Furniture in 2013.
