



Wilhelmina Lewis Detwiler

August 12, 1925 - December 14, 2024

Wilhelmina (Lewis) Detwiler, a lifelong resident of Manassas, died in her sleep on December 14 at the home in Old Town Manassas where she had lived for the past ninety-three years. The only child of George R. Lewis and Rowena (Brown) Lewis, she was born at the family farm outside Manassas on August 12, 1925.

A graduate of Manassas High School (now Osbourn High School) and Strayer College (now University), she worked for the Proffitt Insurance Agency in Manassas. She married Oscar Detwiler on November 8, 1948 and they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 1998 shortly before his passing. She had been a member of Manassas Baptist Church for decades, where she worked with children in numerous church programs and served on several committees.

She is survived by two daughters and sons-in-law: Becky and Dan Verner and Sue and Jerry Pankey, four grandchildren: Amy Verner (Chris Magee), Alyssa Brown (Chris), Jonathan Pankey and Joshua Pankey (Anna) and two great-grandchildren: Elijah and Emma Pankey.

She and her husband Oscar will be remembered for the delicious fruits and vegetables they grew and sold and for the beautiful rose gardens that surrounded their home. Visitation will be held at Manassas Baptist Church

(8800 Sudley Road) on Thursday, December 19 from 4-7 pm and her funeral will be held at Manassas Baptist Church on Friday, December 20 at 1:00 pm, with private interment at Stonewall Memory Gardens the following day.
