William "Grant" Adkins, age 8, died Thursday, February 10, 2005 at Duke University Hospital in Durham, NC.

Grant Adkins ended his long battle with Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma on Thursday morning. He was a brave little boy that faced his illness with the strength of a lion and the gentleness of a lamb.

Grant was a member of Manassas Baptist Church, he attended Phillip Michael Pennington School in Manassas and was on the Urbanna Swim Team, Manassas. He also played soccer and T Ball with the Manassas Baptist Church sports ministries.
