Rev. William Benjamin Day, Jr. age 69 of Manassas, VA died Monday, January 24, 2005 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas.

He began his ministry in 1960 and in 1964 was the founding minister of St. Thomas United Methodist Church, Manassas. Rev. Day was still active in the United Methodist Church, serving as the minister of the Wesleyan United Methodist Church, Calverton and had performed over 4000 weddings. He was a graduate of Duke Divinity School in Durham, North Carolina.

He was preceded in death by his parents, William Benjamin Day, Sr. and Ruth Yates Day and a brother, Dwight Freemont Day. Survivors include his wife of 49 years, Margie Elliott Day, one daughter, Kathryn Ruth Day of the home, one sister, Virginia Day Conger of Silver Spring, Maryland and one brother, Samuel Yates Day of Falls Church.
