May 29, 1940 - July 4, 2011

WILLIAM FREDERICK FREIDANK, age 71 died Monday, July 4, 2011 at his home in Nokesville, Virginia.

Bill was born May 29, 1940 in Huntington, New York to the late William H. and Phyllis V. (Almond) Freidank. A 1962 graduate of St. Michael's College in Winooski, Vermont where he majored in biology and participated in the ROTC color guard. Upon graduation in 1967 from Fairleigh Dickerson Dental School in Teaneck, New Jersey, Bill received early commission as Captain in the U.S. Air Force, stationed at Langley AFB, Newport News, Virginia. While in private practice in Old Town on Main Street, he taught at Georgetown Dental School from 1982 until its closing in 1990. Outgrowing his Main Street office, Bill and his son Christian moved to 9613 Champion Court where Dr. Chris still practices. Bill retired on National Doctor's Day March 30, 2011 after serving the community for 44 years.

He is also preceded in death by one grandson, Christian Bryce Freidank.

Survivors include his loving wife of 48 years, Maureen Freidank; three children, Jennifer A. Irvin and husband Keith of Nokesville, Virginia, Christian W.
