William H. "Bill" Johnson, age 82, of Manassas, Virginia died Saturday, July 3, 2010 at Gainesville Health and Rehab Center. Bill had lived in Manassas his entire life and was the owner and operator of Clover Hill Dairy Farm.

Mr. Johnson was born in Manassas on August 26, 1927, the son of the late Wheatley and Dorothy Haydon Johnson.
