WILLIAM WADE JORDAN, 51 died at home on Monday, July 9, 2007 after a two year battle with cancer.

Wade was born in Washington, DC to the late Charles R. Jordan of Manassas, VA and the late Roberta Fox Payne of Haymarket, VA. He was raised in the town of Haymarket, VA and moved to Manassas, VA shortly after beginning his career with the Fairfax County Police Department.
