William "Bill" Paul Rieck, Sr., retired, died peacefully at his home surrounded by his family on Friday, September 2, 2016. He was born in Cleveland, Ohio and lived in Manassas, Virginia since 1970.

Bill served with honors in the United States Air Force from 1961 to 1965. He retired in 1999 from Specialized Carriers and Rigging Association as a Sr. Executive Vice President.
