William W. May, 91, Retired Judge

William Wendell May, General District Judge from 1959 to 1978 died on Monday, November 29, 2004 in Manassas. He was 91. Born in Paintsville, Kentucky, he went to Washington D.C. in the 30's to gain a law degree. In 1941, when he moved his young family to Hoadly, Judge May became one of only seven practicing attorneys in Prince William County.

He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II and practiced law in Manassas until his late 80's.

His exceptional concern for the welfare of others, and devotion to the law leave an enduring legacy for his family, friends and colleagues. He is deeply mourned by his family and is survived by his brother: Robert, his daughters: Claudia May Moore, Sandy Thybony, Nana Dealy and his grandchildren: Erik, Marian and Anne.
