December 3, 1950 - September 12, 2021

Zarina Chand, 70, of Centreville, Virginia, fell asleep in the Lord on Sunday, September 12, 2021, after a lengthy battle with several severe health issues. She was born to the late Mistri Inayat and Barkat Bibi in Sheikhpura, Pakistan.

She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Master John Diwan Chand and is survived by her brother Pastor Maqbool Inayat, her two sons Jahangir and Zaheer Chand, daughters-in-law Shazia and Saira, and three grandchildren, Jordan, Sheldon and Zen Chand, all living in Virginia.

Zarina graduated from Pakistan Adventist Seminary & College, where she also served as a teacher for 30 years. She enjoyed her job immensely and loved to help people in need. After retiring, Zarina moved to the United States with her late husband John D. Chand to be with their children. She always had a positive outlook on life and a cheerful demeanor, despite enduring cancer, two heart surgeries and several other complications. Her unshakable faith in Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior sustained her throughout her life, particularly during her health battles. She never questioned God's love for her. She was a dedicated member of the Vienna Seventh-Day Adventist Church and spent her days reading the Bible, Ellen G. White's writings and Sabbath School materials printed by the Church.

The viewing and memorial service for Zarina will take place on Monday, September 20, from 9:00AM (Viewing) and 10:00AM (Memorial Service) at the Vienna SDA Church, 344 Courthouse Rd SW, Vienna, VA 22180.

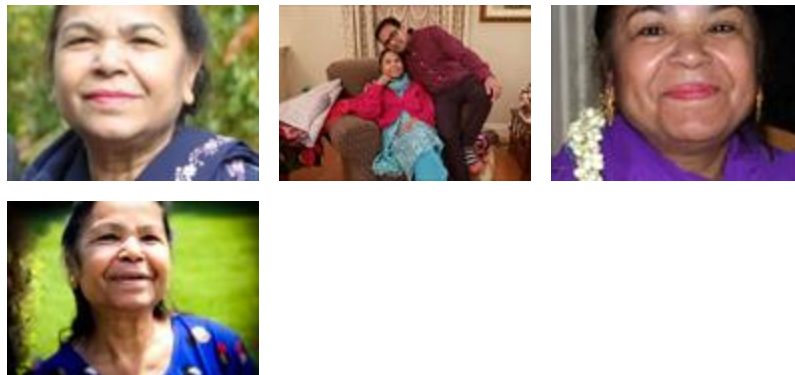
