



## Zollie Canterbury

October 4, 1924 - December 11, 2004

Zollie Edison Canterbury, age 80, of Charlottesville, died on Saturday, December 11, 2004, at Heritage Hall in Charlottesville. He retired as Chief Petty Officer of the Navy after 23 years, including a tour in the Pacific during World War II.
